## PUBLISHING MODULE HOMEWORK: Interiors

Welcome to your **Interior Design Homework!**

Something most of us never think about is that the inside of the book must also be designed. Right? Because if it weren't it would resemble a bad homework assignment turned in late.

And no author wants that!

### The Five Things Your Interior Must Do

- 1. Look \_\_\_\_\_**
  - Do you want it to look handwritten? If so, you either need to write your entire story by hand...and hope everyone can read your writing...or you need a font that looks handwritten.
- 2. Look \_\_\_\_\_**
  - Will there be poems or journaled sections by a character? If so, how will those be presented? A different font? A change of format? Both?
- 3. Look \_\_\_\_\_**
  - How will they be integrated? Will they mark the beginning of a chapter, the end, or have their own page alongside the corresponding text?
- 4. Look \_\_\_\_\_**
  - Widows and orphans? How will words or lines landing on their own page be caught or avoided?

**5. Look \_\_\_\_\_**

- Do you want special section breaks? How will you telegraph a special section in your story?
